What is Wells of Life?

Wells of Life is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization. It's mission is to give clean water to villages in rural Uganda.

Intructions: Read "The 3 Main Goals" and find & circle the key words!

The 3 Main Goals

- 1. **Drill water wells:** Wells of Life is most known for drilling new water wells in villages like Anita's, which have no access to clean water. We dig 50 feet into the earth with stainless steel to bring water to the surface. One well gives health, hope, and happiness to around 1000 people!
- 2. Operation Restoration: Our team goes to villages that previously had a well from other nonprofits but the well has broken down. We restore this well to its working condition that will last for years to come. This again allows villages to have safe and clean access to water.
- 3. **Teach hygiene:** In many villages, families have never heard of how to wash their hands before eating, or to keep their dishes clean. A Wells of Life team lives in a village for 6 months to educate the villagers about the simple, clean practices that keep them healthy.


