Why Water?

When you give clean water you give time, opportunity, education, and empowerment. When a community receives clean water, they are given the resources of health, hygiene, and time to create a more sustainable society.

90% of Ugandans live in rural communities and nearly two-thirds of these communities lack safe access to clean water. Water-borne diseases and infant mortality are horrifying realities for many Ugandans. Like Isaiah proclaimed in a vision, "Here I am Lord." Wells of Life feels the same about being there for the wonderful people inhabiting the most rural areas of Uganda. We have heeded the call to serve the most neglected and most needy.



As of 2021, Grace Church of Chapel Hill has contributed wells to 14 communities, transforming the lives of over 15,486 people.

How to get Involved

Choose your method for transforming lives:

Drill a Clean Water Well - \$8,000

Wells of Life will drill a clean water well at a local church in rural Uganda to serve over 1,000 people.

Drill a cluster of clean water wells **(\$80,000)**

Restore a Well - \$4,000

Wells of Life will rehabilitate a broken well and restore hope to a community of over 1,000. (These wells are drilled and left unmaintained by other NGOs).

Restore a cluster of 10 wells **(\$40,000)**

Healthy Village Program - \$8,000

Provide personal latrines for each household, private bathing stations for women and girls, handwashing stations next to the latrines, dishwashing racks to prevent dishes from drying out on the ground, 9-month training on how to maintain a clean household environment.

Cluster of 10 **(\$80,000)**
