The Healthy Village Program

The extensive 9-month training in village communities includes in-depth training and education on the necessities for sanitation and hygiene.

Main Focuses:

- Personal latrines for each household
- Private bathing stations for women and girls
- Handwashing stations next to the latrines
- Dishwashing racks to prevent dishes from drying out on the dirty ground
- Training on how to maintain a clean household environment
